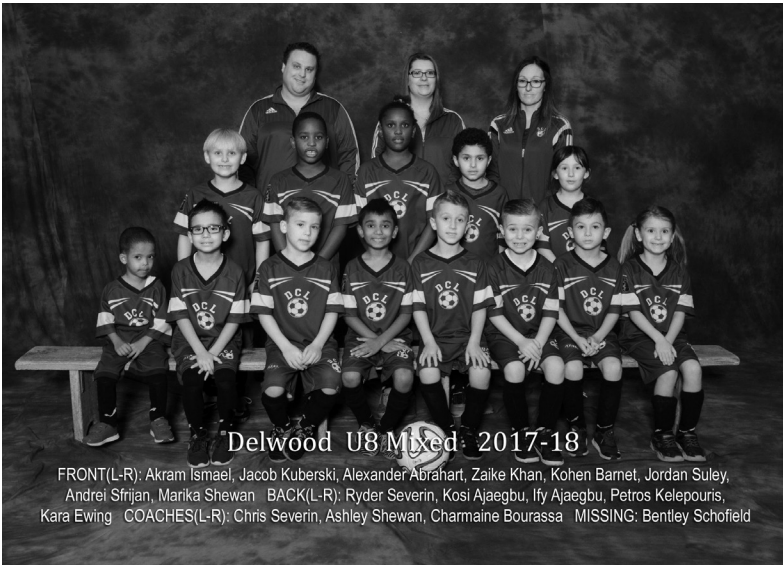

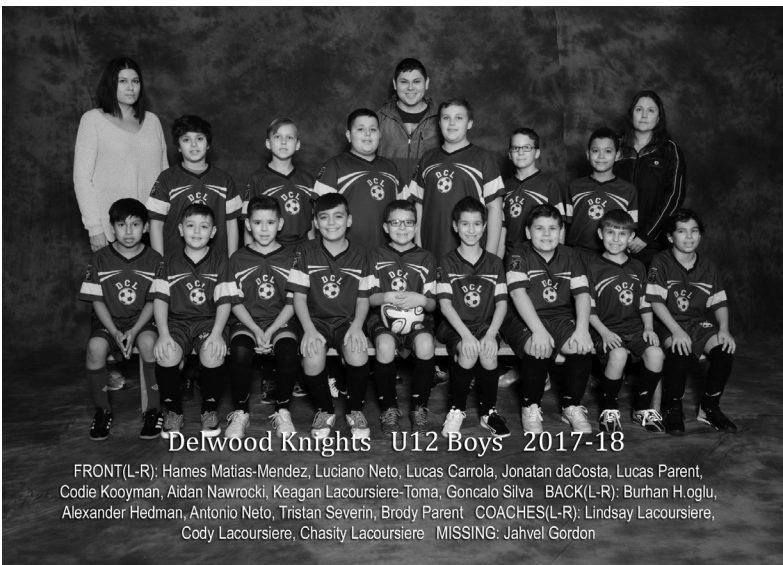
HIGHLIGHTS

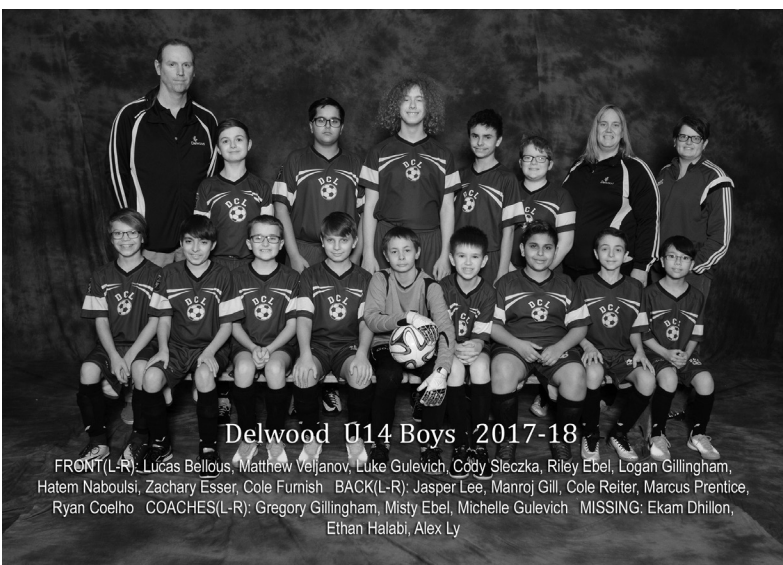

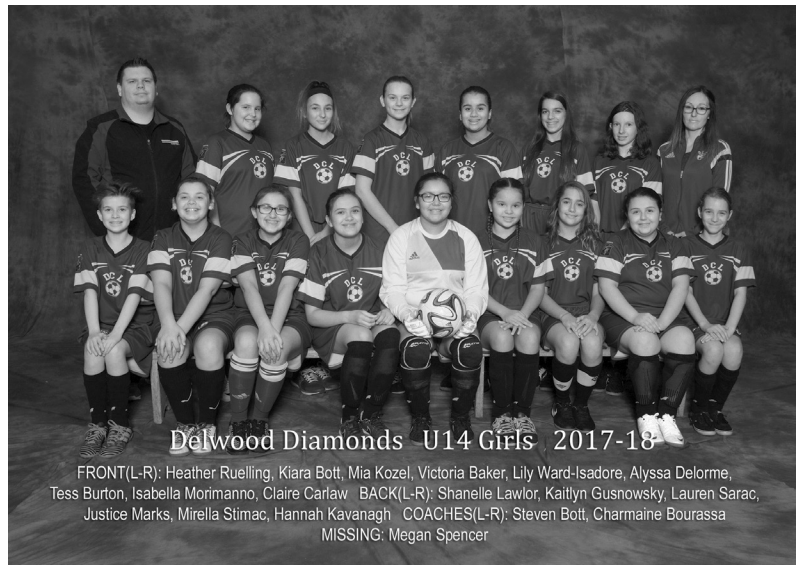

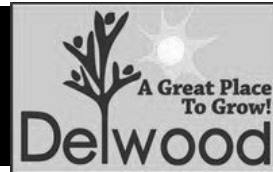
