Outdoor Soccer is Back!

REGISTRATION OPENS ONLINE FEBRUARY 1

Requirements

All players are required to provide a \$200 volunteer deposit. Families are required to complete ONE volunteer shift per player they have registered.

All players are required to provide a \$75 uniform deposit to the Delwood Community League.

Registration requires a current community league membership. If you do not yet have one, visit delwood.ca/membership to purchase one online, or purchase one in-person at our in-person registration.

Coach Incentive Program

Any parent that volunteers and completes the 2025 outdoor soccer season as a Coach or Assistant Coach will receive a one-time reimbursement of soccer fees for up to one of their children, and have their volunteer shift requirement waived. More information about coaching can be found at delwood.ca/soccer.

Step 1: Register Online

Visit cgsa.ca and click on the Delwood Dragons logo to begin the registration process.



Step 2: Finish Registration In-Person

Visit Delwood Hall (7515 Delwood Road NW) on **one** of the dates listed below to finish your registration. **This step is mandatory.**

- Your child's Alberta Healthcare Card
- Cash, debit, or credit payment for registration costs
- Two blank cheques (per child) to complete at registration for the uniform and volunteer deposits.
