Outdoor Soccer is Back!

ONLINE REGISTRATION IS OPEN

Requirements

All players are required to provide a \$200 volunteer deposit. Families are required to complete ONE volunteer shift per player they have registered.

All players are required to provide a \$75 uniform deposit to the Delwood Community League.

Registration requires a current community league membership. If you do not yet have one, visit delwood.ca/membership to purchase one online, or purchase one in-person at our in-person registration.

Coach Incentive Program

Any parent that volunteers and completes the 2025 outdoor soccer season as a Coach or Assistant Coach will receive a one-time reimbursement of soccer fees for up to one of their children, and have their volunteer shift requirement waived.
