Soccer Registration for Indoor Soccer

Online registration opened August 1

Tentatively, games will run on Friday evenings, Saturdays and Sundays between late October 2025 to late February 2026 and be held at Dow Centennial Centre, Servus Place, or Millennium Place, subject to change. U9 and older teams will participate in a minimum of seven practices during the season, scheduled at a later date.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

- A 2025-2026 Community League membership is required to register.
- Players must register with the community they live in and request to transfer to Delwood, unless their community does not have their own CGSA team.
- All plauers are required to provide a \$200 volunteer deposit per plauer up to two players per household.
- All players U9 and older are required to provide a \$75 uniform deposit.

Step 1: Register Online

Visit delwood.ca/soccer and click on the "Complete Online Registration" button to make a new RAMP InterActive account with Delwood, or sign into an existing one.

Step 2: Finish Registration In-Person

Visit Delwood Hall to finish your registration on ONE of the dates below. THIS STEP IS MANDATORY. Please bring:

- Your plauer's Alberta Healthcare Card
- Cash, cheque, debit, or credit payment for registration cost and volunteer deposit (\$200 per player)
